#### ATHLETICS STADIUM AND FIELDS PROJECT

#### **DESIGN**

#### **Project Description**

The Athletics Facilities Feasibility study was completed in 2020, and identified a menu of options, which were prioritized and assembled into proposed phases. This phase will demolish the existing football stadium and construct a new 20,000 sf stadium building which will house team locker rooms and associated auxiliary spaces, a 3,000 sf weight room, sports official facilities, and support areas including equipment storage rooms, laundry, video, and IT rooms. In addition, the project will install new sports lighting at both the football and soccer fields and create landscaped new and renovated parking.



#### COACHELLA CHELSEA PROPERTY TENANT IMPROVEMENT

#### DESIGN

#### **Project Description**

Tenant improvement of leased space in the heart of Coachella. The commercial units (#10 and #20 of Pueblo Viejo Villas) will be the new location for Student Services, which is currently temporarily located in the old Coachella Library. The 1,366 sf space is a "Cold Dark Shell" which requires full improvements including, but not limited to, framing and drywall installations, HVAC, fire alarm and sprinklers, interior paint, new flooring, acoustical ceiling, lighting, electrical alterations, data, and communication. The finished space will have two (2) single occupancy restrooms, two (2) offices, a Greeter's station, a computer lab with open workstations and a tutorial workshop space with systems furniture and audio visual equipment.

The expansion of College of the Desert's Indio Campus includes 10,000 sf of renovations to the existing building. Renovations include the removal of various campus level functions that are to be rehoused in the new building, the enclosure of the breezeway, and the conversion of the newly available spaces into additional instructional and student study spaces. Site improvements include removal of the temporary modular classroom buildings and resurfacing that portion of the parking lot.



#### PALM SPRINGS DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

#### DESIGN

#### **Project Description**

The planning and development of a new campus on approximately 27 acres of reclaimed land in Palm Springs. The campus will accommodate a combination of traditional instruction methodologies and hands-on technical education. Informed by industry partners and local stakeholders, the campus will establish and augment signature programs including Hospitality and Culinary Arts, Digital Media and Entertainment, Center of Excellence for Healthcare Education, and Sustainable Technologies. To accommodate these programs, the project includes construction of an education Accelerator containing flexible classrooms, meeting spaces, student services, maker spaces, and high-tech learning laboratories. A large Culinary Institute is planned to accommodate Palm Springs' robust restaurant industry. In addition, a full-service Learning Hotel, Conference and Event Center, and gracious site amenities are planned to engage the Desert community and serve the larger region. The development is to be executed as a world-class facility that will prepare students for immediate employment and lifelong, fulfilling careers.



#### SCIENCE BUILDING RENOVATION PROJECT

#### DESIGN

#### **Project Description**

The project scope includes the interior renovation and modernization of the Science Building, originally built in the early 1960's and partially upgraded in 2002. Located on the College's Palm Desert campus, it is part of the campus's core complex of "historic" buildings. The intent is to preserve the original exterior architecture of the building while upgrading its structure and services to meet current codes. The existing building is approximately 15,025 gsf in size, of which 10,150 sf is considered assignable space. The project's current scope of work will require the demolition of the interior with a complete interior remodel providing new laboratory and classroom spaces with the latest technology, finishes and lighting, all providing an enhanced instruction experience. Building support spaces, laboratory services and new staff offices will also be included with an efficient layout connected by minimal circulation/hall space to maximize space efficiency. The remodel will also include the replacement of all utilities including, but not limited to the electrical, plumbing, and mechanical systems, including new exhaust systems for the laboratory hoods. A new roof will be provided as part of the minimal Exterior improvements.

#### INDIO CAMPUS EXPANSION - NEW BUILDING AND SITE DEVELOPMENT

#### CONSTRUCTION

#### **Project Description**

The expansion of College of the Desert's Indio Campus extends the campus site north of the existing building with the addition of a new 67,000 sf building, and site enhancements that include a new shade structure and flexible outdoor space between the buildings. The new building includes an enlarged Student Success Center, Public Safety facilities and Student Health Offices. It will significantly expand the instructional facilities with new classrooms, science laboratories, lecture halls, computer labs and a Maker Space, expanded faculty office space, a student dining commons and study spaces. The building will also have the necessary support and circulation spaces for maintenance of the Indio Campus, various informal social spaces along corridors, and a large outdoor deck space on the third level. Site improvements include parking lots, landscape buffers, and vehicular circulation for the new enlarged campus extents.



#### INDIO CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER

#### **Project Description**

The Child Development Center at College of the Desert's Indio Campus extends the campus site south of the existing building with the addition of a new 18,000 sf building and approximately 7,000 sf of Play Yards with shade structures. The new building will include toddler & preschool classrooms, 2 of each, and support spaces required for a state of the art child care facility, meeting State Chancellor's guidelines. The building will also house an adult ECE classroom and observation spaces. Site improvements include undergrounding of existing overhead utilities, demolition of existing structures and new parking lots.


