

**Flinn Fagg, AICP**  
**Deputy City Manager, City of Palm Springs**

Flinn Fagg, AICP, joined the City of Palm Springs in September 2014 as the Director of Planning Services. In his role with the City, he has overseen an update to the Downtown Specific Plan, worked on the adoption of a new historic preservation ordinance, and prepared various updates to the zoning code to facilitate housing development. In his current role as Deputy City Manager, he oversees the Development Services departments (Building & Safety, Community & Economic Development, Engineering, Planning, and Sustainability) and assists with the City's legislative agenda.

He previously served as the Planning Director for the City of Las Vegas, where he led efforts to adopt walkable community plans, revised the zoning code to include Complete Streets standards and sustainability practices, and implemented an Academy of Planning course for residents.

His previous experience includes work as an urban planner and designer for several cities in Florida. He has also worked for architectural firms, including a firm in Miami Beach that specialized in the rehabilitation of historic structures within the Art Deco Historic District.

Flinn has been a member of the American Planning Association (APA) since 1994, and received his AICP certification in 1998. He has served on both state and national APA boards, and has assisted with program development for the APA National Planning Conference.

Flinn is a graduate of the University of Oregon, where he earned a Bachelor of Architecture degree. He obtained his Master of Architecture degree at the University of Miami, specializing in urban design.
