Welding (Evenings at Palm Springs High School) – Skills-based technical training for immediate employment or further certification.

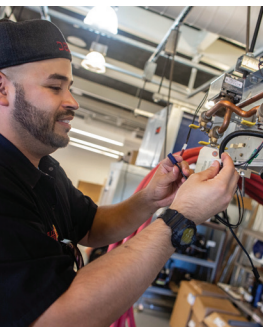

Palm Springs High School

Desert Hot Springs High School
